# Introducing the new Bronze medal awards

The Lifesaving Society is excited to announce the official release of the revised Bronze medal awards! The update improves skill progressions for a seamless flow into National Lifeguard and sets candidates up for success as they move through the Society's lifesaving, assistant lifeguard and lifeguard continuum.

We outline the changes in three communiques:

- What's new for recertifying Bronze Cross candidates?

#### Highlights include:

- Bronze Star focuses on swimming proficiency, lifesaving skill and physical fitness.
- Bronze Medallion reintroduces lifesaving strokes.
- Bronze Cross introduces fundamental assistant lifeguard skills
- Standardized Bronze Medallion and Bronze Cross recertification exams.

There are no changes to prerequisites.

# What Lifesaving Instructors need to know

- Find out when your employer plans to launch the new Bronze program – they have until June 2022 to switch.
- Attend a Bronze Update Clinic before teaching the new curriculum.
- Purchase the new <u>Bronze Medals Award Guide</u>, which includes all the Test Items and Must Sees. The new <u>Teaching Bronze</u> USB flash drive has more than a hundred pages of additional resources including core and lesson plans, learning activities and videos.

## Is the Bronze Update Clinic mandatory? Is it worth a credit towards my instructor recertification?

The Bronze Update Clinic is mandatory. You will receive 3 leadership recertification credits upon successful completion of the clinic.

### Where do I get the new resources?

You can buy the <u>Bronze Medals Award Guide</u>, <u>Medallion</u> and <u>Cross</u> workbooks and the <u>Teaching Bronze</u> USB flash drive from LifeguardDepot.com.

### New Bronze test sheets

The test sheets for the new Bronze medal awards are now available in English and in French in Find a Form on our website.

Instructors, Examiners and recertifying candidates should take note that the Society has standardized Bronze Medallion and Bronze Cross recertification exams by designating mandatory — and only — items to be evaluated. To facilitate this, the Society has prepared separate Recertification test sheets that must be used when submitting Medallion and Cross recertification candidates for the new (2020) awards.

The new *Bronze Medals Award Guide* has been available since March and the award descriptions and test items have been updated accordingly in <a href="Swimming & Lifesaving">Swimming & Lifesaving</a> and <a href="Lifeguarding">Lifeguarding</a> on the Society's website.

Affiliates may implement the new Bronze medal awards at their convenience by June 2022, so instructors and examiners need to be ready. Check with your employer about when they plan to start using the new Bronze medals curriculum.



### Lifesaving Society and Swimming Canada collaborate on lane swimming safety standards

The guide to <u>Single Lane Swimming for Competitive Swimmers</u> is available on the <u>COVID-19</u> section of the Society's website. The document describes how multiple swimmers can train in a single lane with minimal risk of COVID-19 transmission during competitive/club swim training and reflects a collaborative effort between Swimming Canada and Lifesaving Society Canada. The guide has effectively helped over 23,000 swimmers to participate in 282,000 swims across Canada (and counting).


